DEVELOPMENT UPDATE

Warralily was Victoria's only winner at this year's national awards event strengthening the estate's position as the most awarded urban environment in the Geelong region.

We are very proud to have created a truly modern and live-able community where the urban environment lives in harmony with the natural environment.

The award recognises the rehabilitation and re-construction of 2.8 kilometers of the degraded creek corridor which has delivered an exemplar of integrated stormwater management and protected the sustainability of downstream internationally recognised Ramsar wetlands.

Armstrong Creek has laid the foundation for this community's distinctive sense of place and intimate relationship with its landscape.

This 380-hectare greenfield site, positioned between the Geelong CBD and the Surf Coast's iconic beaches, is now the largest and leading development in the growth corridor.













With 68 stages now complete, over 550 lots currently under construction and over 7,000 residents, Warralilians can enjoy the very best of contemporary urban design with retail, education, sport and community facilities on our doorstep.

St Catherine's is currently being constructed on 2.8-hectare site at 131 Warralily Boulevard and the \$5.7m stage one will include two storey teaching and learning and administration areas, adventure playgrounds with grassed areas for space to run and hard-court play area. The final school will be built over four stages. The school has been designed to grow to an eventual enrolment of 500 students.

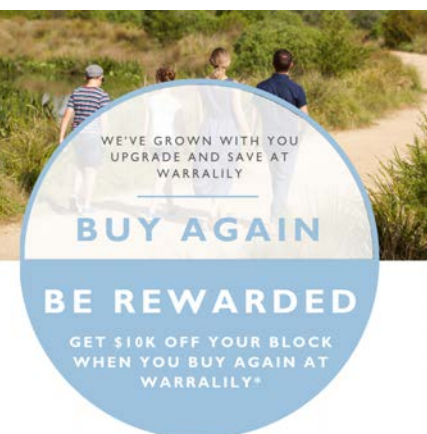
